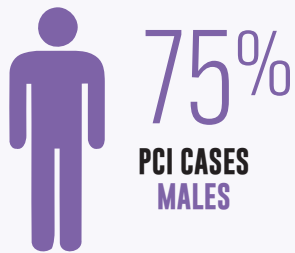

## FASTFACTS



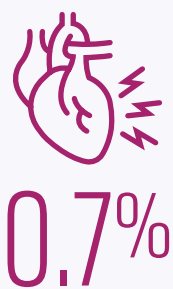
**75% of all PCI cases** reported were performed on males, whose average age was **64 years**.



**76% of all cases** received PCI mediated reperfusion within  $\leq 90$ mins to re-establish blood flow and oxygen to the heart after the person enters ED.



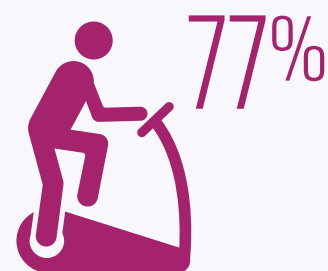
**Radial access** is the predominant arterial approach for PCI and is associated with **lower bleeding rates**.



In hospital major bleeding rate was **0.7%** and major adverse events were **highest among STEMI patients**.



The **in-hospital mortality rate** was **2%**.



The overall rate of referral to **cardiac rehabilitation** was **77%** and was lower in low volume centres.
