NCR DATA 2023

The NCR is currently capturing **50%** of all PCIs performed annually, across Australia* 25,223 procedures were performed on 22,665 patients

0/0 of cases were performed on males, whose **average age** was **65.7 years**

19.6%

of PCI procedures were performed **out-of-hours**





The **in-hospital major bleeding rate**, a potential complication, was 0.5% and was lower among radial access cases - 0.3%

PCI for acute coronary syndromes (ACS) accounted for 54.6% of the caseload Radial access is the predominant arterial approach for PCI, and is performed in **80.7% of procedures**. This rate has been increasing gradually since 2019



The overall rate of **referral to cardiac rehabilitation was 78.1%**.

This was lower amongst low volume hospitals - **74.3%**

The in-hospital mortality rate was

30-day unplanned cardiac readmission rate was

3.2%

Major adverse cardiac event rate including; death, new myocardial infarction, stent thrombosis, unplanned revascularisation or stroke was highest among STEMI patients - 7.6% compared to the overall cohort at 2.6%
