EMPOWER STAKEHOLDERS WITH NCR DATA FOR QUALITY IMPROVEMENT

- Increase analysis and reporting capabilities in collaboration with Clinicians, Consumers and other key stakeholders
- Mature variation analysis and management
- Mature Consumer engagement

INCREASE NATIONAL PARTICIPATION OF PCI HOSPITALS

- Implement a national hospital engagement program
- Strengthen NCR's Value Proposition
- Monitor and report participation progress transparently

MODERNISE DIGITAL INFRASTRUCTURE AND DATA ACCESSIBILITY

- Assess NCR data quality, accessibility and digital technologies
- Collaborate and leverage from jurisdictional technologies and processes for innovative solutions
- Implement new digital technologies and platform upgrades

EXPAND REGISTRY SCOPE WITH NEW MODULES AND DATASETS
